Children Looked After

• The Virtual School have commissioned Hull City Psychological Service to work on behalf of CLA learners within the city. School staff and social workers can refer directly into the Virtual School if they feel that a psychological perspective, regarding a learner, may be helpful. This typically involves holding a HART Consultation for the learner but the Service is also piloting HAILs for learners who are struggling to feel safe attending school.
