

- Hull General Practitioner.
- Parent/carer consented to referral.
- Sensory processing difficulties having a *significant impact* on mental health and/or physical wellbeing in more than one environment.



 Sensory processing difficulties that are *severe* and *longstanding* and are having a direct impa on their daily functioning.
