

Our ethos



- We will work with pupils either individually or as a small group
- Being able to feedback to staff is essential
- Modelling to staff is one of the most effective support strategies as you are there everyday
- We will give you as much advice as you would like in relation to meeting communication and interaction needs
- We can provide whole school environmental support through training, learning walks, subject specific support (this is very effective in secondary settings)
- We are always happy to respond to emails and phone calls – no question is a silly question

What our support looks like at the different tiers

Tier 1

We will have sessions running as part of the universal training offer at the central location.

We are at the end of the phone, an email, a Teams meeting for any questions/support at the universal level.

Tier 2

You can book specific training or request environmental support

Tier 3

Individual pupil referrals resulting in support at either low or high level.
